Overview

The Green Agenda is a five-bill legislative plan built from lived experience — not political theory.

It focuses on the issues affecting everyday Oklahomans: housing, education, safety, economic security, and rural opportunity.

Each bill stands on its own, but together they form a comprehensive blueprint for rebuilding the American middle class, protecting children and families, and restoring trust in government.

This isn't about left or right. It's about what's right for people.

1. THE G.R.E.E.N. ACT

Growing Rural Equity, Empowerment & Navigation

A federal commitment to rural communities through healthcare expansion, small business support, infrastructure investment, broadband access, and transparent government spending.

What it delivers:

- Rural healthcare access (including Medicare-for-All pilots)
 - Rural mental health expansion
 - Stronger support for family farms and small businesses
 - Broadband and infrastructure modernization
 - Government accountability and anti-corruption measures

2. THE UPHS ACT

Unhoused Protection & Housing Stability Act

A comprehensive plan to protect the unhoused, prevent homelessness, stabilize renters, build affordable homes, and curb predatory corporate ownership of housing.

What it delivers:

- Emergency shelters, transitional housing & crisis outreach
 - Eviction prevention & national renter protections
 - Affordable starter-home construction
 - Restrictions on Wall Street bulk-buying
 - First-time homebuyer support & down-payment assistance
 - Neighborhood revitalization and community land trusts

3. THE FREEDOM TO THRIVE ACT

Economic Security for Working Families

A pro-worker economic package supporting families through wage growth, childcare affordability, paid leave, labor rights, and workforce development.

What it delivers:

- Indexing wages to cost-of-living
 - Affordable childcare
 - Paid family & medical leave
 - Penalties for wage theft & worker exploitation
 - Apprenticeships and job training
 - Gig-worker protections

4. THE GUARDIAN & SAFE HAVEN ACT

Protecting Children, Strengthening Families & Ending Exploitation

Your flagship bill is a national plan to protect children, prevent trafficking, support survivors, reform foster care, and strengthen family stability.

What it delivers:

- National anti-trafficking strategy
 - Stronger penalties for traffickers & buyers
 - Mandatory training for schools, law enforcement & healthcare
 - Survivor housing, recovery, and mental-health support
 - Safety standards for foster & youth facilities
 - Reporting system for missing foster youth
 - Protections for disabled & medically fragile children
 - Family-preservation support and youth aging-out assistance

5. THE PUBLIC EDUCATION STRENGTH & OPPORTUNITY ACT***Strong Schools. Strong Teachers. Strong Futures.***

A federal blueprint for improving public education, supporting teachers, modernizing facilities, and expanding opportunities for all students.

What it delivers:

- Teacher pay raises & recruitment incentives
 - Full funding of special education (IDEA)
 - Mental-health counselors & trauma-informed staff
 - Rural school investment & facility upgrades
 - Smaller class sizes
 - Career, technical & trade education expansion
 - College & workforce readiness
 - Transparent, accountable school funding
